CONDITIONS FOR SPECIAL EVENT LICENCE - PUBLIC RESALE FUNCTIONS

1. MAXIMUM HOURS

- auction of liquor product may take place between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. unless otherwise approved by the AGLC

2. LICENSEE

- the licensee must be licensed in Alberta as an auction sales business under the Public Auctions Regulation
- the licensee cannot be the owner/seller of the liquor products

3. LOCATION

- the auction may not take place in a Class A, B, C, D or E licensed premises

4. AUTHORIZED LIQUOR

- homemade spirits, beer or wine MAY NOT be stored or sold
- unauthorized liquor may be subject to seizure by police or AGLC inspectors and violators may be charged under the Gaming and Liquor Act

5. RECORDS

- the licensee must maintain a record of the name, address, and contact information of each buyer of all liquor products for a minimum of one year
- the record must be made available to the AGLC upon request

6. STORAGE AND SECURITY

- illegal activities are not permitted at auctions and police should be informed of any illegal activity encountered
- all stored liquor product must be kept in a locked, secure area or facility

7. INSPECTIONS

- special event licence functions may be inspected by police or AGLC inspectors who must be allowed entry

8. SPECIAL EVENT LICENCES

- licensees are legally responsible to ensure all liquor laws and regulations are followed - failure to do so may result in the loss of licence entitlement
